

Students, grades K-8, transferring to Caldwell School District No. 132, from non-state approved schools, public, private, or parochial, may be required to demonstrate proficiency in the subjects required by the state and/or district for placement at the appropriate grade level. The demonstration of proficiency may include, but not be limited to, standardized tests, locally prepared tests, and/or oral tests conducted by a single teacher or group of teachers within the school district. Other modes of assessment may be utilized as appropriate.

Credits of transfer students from non-state accredited high schools will not be accepted until proficiency in subjects claimed has been verified by the building principal or his designee.

Credits and records of transfer students, grade K-12 from state approved or accredited schools will be accepted upon receipt of the official transcript or record which lists the subjects completed and the grades earned in those subjects.
