

The Caldwell School District prohibits students from committing any act on property belonging to the Caldwell School District, or at any school-sponsored activity, that could be considered a felony under Idaho Code. These acts would be considered a violation of district policy. Such acts include, but are not limited to the following:

1. Possession of Methamphetamine, Cocaine, LSD, Marijuana (over three ounces), or any other controlled substance that the possession of which would be considered a felony under Idaho Code § 37-2732, et. seq.
2. Possession with intent to deliver a controlled substance, I.C. § 37-2732, et. seq.
3. Possession of a controlled substance without a prescription, I.C. § 37-2732, et. seq.
4. Delivery of a controlled substance, I.C. § 37-2732, et. seq.
5. Trafficking in controlled substances, I.C. § I.C. § 37-2732, et. seq.
6. Aggravated Assault, I.C. § 18-905
7. Aggravated Battery, I.C. § 18-907
8. Battery with the intent to commit a serious felony, I.C. § 18-911
9. Assault or battery upon certain personnel, I.C. § 18-915
10. False reports of explosives, I.C. § 18-3313
11. Sexual abuse of a child under the age of sixteen years, I.C. § 18-1506
12. Possession of sexually exploitative material, I.C. § 18-1507A
13. Lewd conduct with minor child under sixteen, I.C. § 18-1508
14. Rape, I.C. §§ 18-6101 and 18-6108
15. Enticing of children, I.C. § 18-1509
16. Malicious injury to property, I.C. § 18-7001

## **DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS**

1. Suspension: The student will be suspended from school up to a maximum of fifteen (15) school days upon the superintendent's recommendation.
2. Parent Notification: The parent/legal guardian will be notified of the offense.
3. Law Enforcement Referral: The student will be referred to the appropriate law enforcement agency.
4. Expulsion: The principal will refer the matter to the superintendent's office. The superintendent or designee will recommend that the board of trustees expel the student. Upon a determination by the Board of Trustees that the policy has been violated, the Board of Trustees shall expel the student for not less than one calendar year; such expulsion shall not be stayed.
5. Any action taken under this Policy shall be in compliance with the rules and regulations outlined by the IDEA.
