

INVESTIGATION AND DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS FOR VIOLATION OF WEAPONS POLICY

1. The principal or designee will immediately **confiscate** any item identified as a weapon or firearm.
2. **Parents** are contacted.
3. The principal or designee will immediately report any incident which is reasonably believed to violate Idaho Code Section 18-3302D to the local **law enforcement** agency and will cooperate with any investigation by the agency, including, but not limited to handing over the item which was confiscated.
4. Students reasonably believed to be in possession of these items may be suspended from school until a thorough investigation is completed. Any conduct which is determined to violate this policy may result in disciplinary action, up to and including formal **suspension and expulsion**.
5. If found to have violated the weapons policy, the student and parents/guardians will appear before the Board of Review and/or the Board of Trustees for an expulsion hearing.
6. According to Idaho Code 18-3302, there is no expectation of privacy for students for the purpose of enforcing this policy. Employees of the district have the right to search all students, their belongings or lockers when it is reasonably believed there is a violation of this policy.
