

**STUDENTS**

1. Present a request for released time for private music lessons to the building principal.
2. Students requesting released time for private music lessons must be in at least the Fourth Grade.
3. Released time shall be from the elective music classes. Such released time shall not be counted as an absence from school.
4. All travel to and from the private lesson shall be within the released time period and the student's free time before school, at noon, or after school.
5. District No. 132 assumes no responsibility for injuries sustained by a student during his released time.

**MUSIC TEACHERS**

1. Must register a valid Idaho Teaching Certificate in the School District Office.
2. A music teacher desiring to have students released for private lessons is to register with the school giving the following information:
  - A. Name of music teacher
  - B. Type of music lesson
  - C. Name of student involved
  - D. Time student is to take private lesson
  - E. Idaho Teaching Certificate number and endorsements.

**EVALUATION OF PRIVATE MUSIC LESSON INSTRUCTION**

Credit for private music lessons will be recorded by the Caldwell Public Schools on permanent records if they meet the accreditation standards.

**FINAL APPROVAL**

Approval of request will be based upon:

- A. Academic standing of student; average or above

- B. Record of attendance; free of truancies
- C. Evidence of good citizenship

Continued approval for released time rests with the principal of the school whose decision is final.

No private lessons (those for which the student pays a fee) shall be given in the school building.
