

All students who have successfully completed all graduation requirements for Caldwell High School as per Policy #610 High School Graduation Requirements and are in good standing may participate in graduation exercises. However, any student who has otherwise met all scholastic requirements for graduation will be granted a diploma, whether or not he or she participates in graduation exercises.

The principal of Caldwell High School is authorized to withhold participation privileges in the graduation exercises and other senior activities for good cause which includes but is not limited to disciplinary actions. The principal, upon withholding the participation privileges, will make an immediate and complete report to the superintendent whose decision will be final.

### **Foreign Students**

Typically foreign students do not participate in Caldwell High School graduation. If a foreign student wishes to receive a regular diploma from the district, he/she must complete all district graduation requirements. This includes submission of an official transcript of credits completed prior to enrollment in the district. If appropriate, the transcript(s) and related information from other schools must be translated into English by the institution issuing the transcript. The translated transcript will be evaluated along with classes taken here in the United States to determine whether or not all of the graduation requirements have been met. It is the responsibility of the foreign student sponsoring organization and foreign student to secure and submit all materials. The Caldwell School District is not responsible for acquiring the materials.

Foreign students not meeting the district graduation requirements per Policy #610 High School Graduation Requirements will not participate in the diploma exchange portion of the graduation ceremony.
