

The buildings and grounds owned by the district are to be used only for educational purposes or other public purposes as approved by the board or its authorized representatives.

Patrons are welcome to visit the schools and administrative offices of the Caldwell School District. Each of the district's schools schedules a variety of activities throughout the year including: open houses, parent-teacher conferences, family math nights and other meetings designed to promote greater involvement of parents with their student's educational program.

Any person who comes onto district property and who disrupts the educational processes, or whose presence is detrimental to the morals, health, safety, academic learning or discipline of the students, or who loiters may be removed. Such persons will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.

All school visitors must report immediately to the school's administrative office prior to preceding to any classroom or activity and obtain a visitor's pass/badge.

Unauthorized persons will not be permitted in school buildings or on school grounds. School principals are authorized to take appropriate action to prevent unauthorized persons from entering district grounds or buildings. Those who do not leave should be advised of the policy and the Police Department called if the violator persists.
